APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Completed application packets must be received by 1600 hours on October 4, 2024; late applications will not be considered.

Applicants whose qualifications are deemed best suited for the position will be notified via email after the closing date and invited to an Oral interview. Date and time TBD.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

(The applicant must prove that all qualifications have been met **before the date of hire).**

- 21 years of age or older.
- High school diploma or G.E.D.
- Valid Arizona Driver’s License (or ability to obtain before employment).
- Five years’ experience in automotive service work including experience in servicing heavy equipment
- Experience in one or more areas of the following: fire apparatus repair, diesel and gasoline engine repair, electrical and mechanical systems diagnostics, and repair.
- Any combination of experience and training would provide the required knowledge and abilities.
- Speak, read, and write the English language.
- Ability to pass the pre-employment medical/physical examination.
- Meet insurability requirements of the district’s insurance carrier.
